

BMW CCA CLUB RACING – PREGNANCY POLICY

WAIVER\Acknowledgement of Risk

The BMW CCA Club Racing Medical committee has taken the stance that driving racecars while pregnant possesses many unnecessary risks to unborn children. During the first trimester the risks for injury to the child from x-rays needing to be done to stabilize an injured driver can result in birth defects. After the first trimester the potential for placental injury in a non- life threatening crash is high.

We do not recommend racing while pregnant.

We strongly advise against racing after the first trimester.

Racers are encouraged to seek medical advice from their physician(s) regarding their participation in BMW CCA Club Racing while pregnant or if they may be pregnant.

Anyone wishing to race while pregnant must sign this acknowledgement accepting the responsibility for any fetal injury that occurs from a crash or the medical stabilization that occurs after a crash.
